

SUBGROUP D (INTERCULTURAL EDUCATION)

Minutes of the meeting on 6th May 2010, Lüneburg

1. Administrative Matters:

2. Presentation of Leuphana Universität by Sabine Remdisch. The structure and the learning levels of the university were presented. We got information about LLL and volunteerism.

3. Review of the VALUE website and collecting the ideas:

- c. Emese Marosszéki will send case study in Hungarian to Carol Stewart and to Malgorzata Kolodziejczyk in May 2010.
- d. Emese Marosszéki will prepare the national report in English and Hungarian and send it to Carol Stewart and to Malgorzata Kolodziejczyk till the end of June 2010.

4. Ideas for the conference in Ankara in 2011:

1. European Year of Volunteering is in 2011 so Subgroup D suggests the VALUE management group to apply for extra foundation to the European Commission.

2. Subgroup D suggests to organise **the World Café** and the workshops in an interactive way. The World Café method was attached. <http://www.kstoolkit.org/The+World+Cafe>

Subgroup D suggests that every subgroup will prepare questions to be discussed in the World Café groups.

Subgroup D has already prepared four questions:

- How can volunteers be involved in getting people from different cultures together?

- How can volunteering projects be systematically structured in order to become a method of LLL?
- What can the different stakeholders (University, volunteers, and target groups) benefit from volunteering?
- What are the benefits of intercultural interaction for volunteers and target groups?

3. Subgroup D can also offer workshops (the members of the subgroup will be the leaders of the workshops. (Sabine Remdisch, Emrah Yıldırım, Malgorzata Kolodziejczyk, Emese Marosszéki)

The title of workshops led by Subgroup D is:

“LLL through volunteering: Principles, intercultural aspects, good practices and methods.”

Subgroup D offers the workshop session, which will last about 6 hours. We would like to work with the same group of maximum 15 people. The 4 topics of the workshops are built on each other so we need the participation of the same group of people.

Agenda of the workshops:

1. “LLL through volunteering, principles” - introduction to the topic presented by Sabine Remdisch.
2. “Intercultural aspects of volunteering” - presentation of İLK YAR program prepared by Emrah Yıldırım + Interactive discussion of the rules put into the manual led by Emrah.
3. “Good practices of intercultural education activities” - prepared by Malgorzata Kolodziejczyk.
4. “Twelve step program for successful volunteer coordinators” - interactive presentation by Emese Marosszéki.

This workshop session will cover different aspects of the main topic of the subgroup D.
